

Documenting Nursing Rehabilitation/Restorative Care (P3)



Definition: A nursing intervention program that assists or promotes the resident's ability to attain his or her maximum potential.

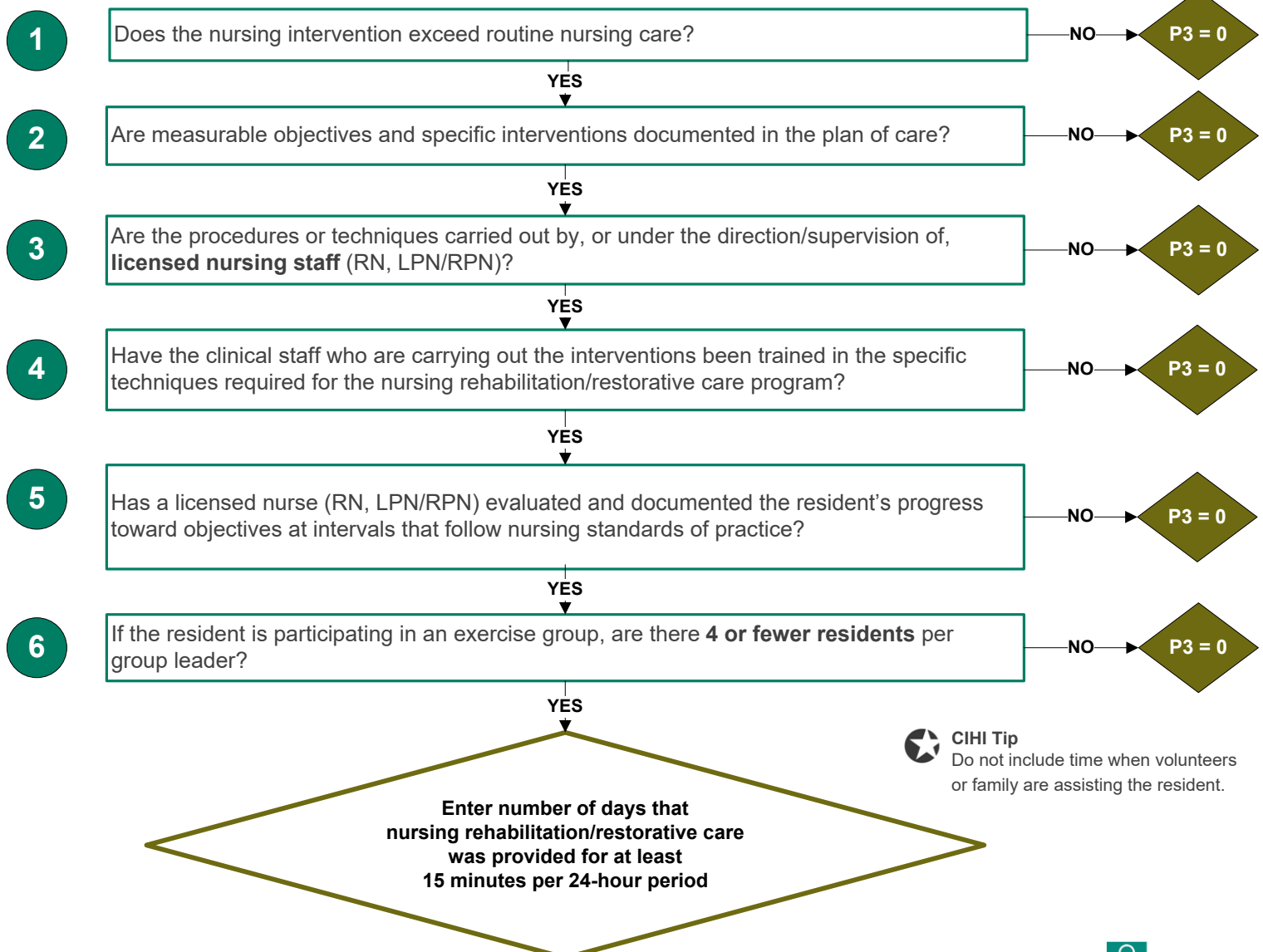
Key Conditions: The nursing intervention must **exceed** routine nursing care and be provided by **clinical** staff (RN, LPN/RPN, assistant/aide).

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| Range of motion—passive (P3a) | Bed mobility (P3d) | Eating or swallowing (P3h) |
| Range of motion—active (P3b) | Transfer (P3e) | Amputation or prosthesis care (P3i) |
| Splint or brace assistance (P3c) | Walking (P3f) | Communication (P3j) |
| | Dressing or grooming (P3g) | Other (P3k) |

A nursing rehabilitation or restorative program must meet ALL of the following criteria
