- **Start**, **Information** and **To-do**

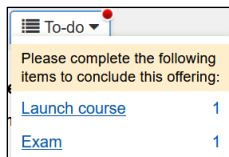
A workshop session will have only the **Information** and **Calendar** buttons.

The Resource collection product will have only the **Information** button.

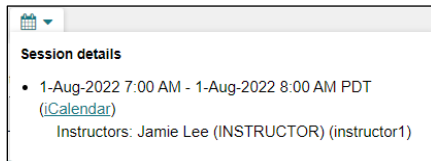
Start, Information, Calendar

Start, Information, To-do

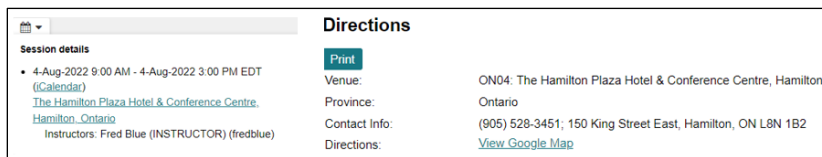
- The **Start** button launches all self-study courses and live web conferences.
- The **Information** button displays course information.
- The **Calendar** button gives you the option to import session information into a calendar application such as Microsoft Outlook.
- The **To-do** button lists items you need to complete to obtain a certificate.
 - Online courses will display a “to-do” list required to complete the course.



- A live web conference session will display the session start/end date, time and the instructor's name.



- A workshop session will display the session start/end date, time and the instructor's name. By clicking on the venue name, a new window will open to show the location and a Google Maps link.



You'll also have access to

- Course resources;
- The exam (if applicable);
- A course certificate (upon completion); and
- A course evaluation.

The **Withdraw enrolment** button is available should you wish to withdraw from the course.

Select **Personal notebook** in the navigation pane if you want to take notes during or after the course. You'll be able to save and print or access them again for later use.

- You can also view information about the type of certificate awarded for successfully completing the course, your records/transcripts for the course and any additional information available about this course by selecting **Certificate**, **Records/transcript** or **Additional information** in the navigation pane.
